13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
14	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 36 O.S. 2011, Section 1250.6, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	Section 1250.6. A. Every property and casualty insurer, within
17	thirty (30) days after receiving notification of a claim, shall
18	acknowledge the receipt of such notification unless payment is made
19	within such period of time. If an acknowledgement is made by means
20	other than writing, an appropriate notation of such acknowledgement
21	shall be made in the claim file of the property and casualty
22	insurer, and dated. Notification given to an agent of a property
23	and casualty insurer shall be notification to the insurer.

1	B. Every property and casualty insurer, upon receiving
2	notification of a claim, promptly shall provide necessary claim
3	forms, instruction $_{m{ au}}$ and reasonable assistance so that first party
4	claimants can comply with the policy conditions and the reasonable
5	requirements of the property and casualty insurer. Compliance with
6	this paragraph within thirty (30) days after notification of a claim
7	shall constitute compliance with subsection A of this section.
8	C. On or after notice of a claim, every property and casualty
9	insurer shall, upon request of a claimant or a representative of the
10	claimant, disclose to the requester, within ten (10) days of the
11	request, the insurance limits of each policy or contract available
12	to pay the claim. In the event a lawsuit is filed before the
13	expiration of the ten (10) days, the Oklahoma Discovery Code shall
14	apply to disclosure of the limits.
15	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
