7	An Act relating to school employee organizations;
8	prohibiting certain existing organizations from continuing to represent certain employees; requiring a school district board of education to direct
9	certain election to certify the existing
10	organization; directing the board of education to determine how the election shall be conducted;
11	authorizing the board of education to establish a fee schedule to fund the election; providing for
12	decertification of an organization if it fails to receive a sufficient number of votes; providing for
13	continuation of certain terms of certain contract if an organization is decertified; allowing school
14	district employees to certify a new employee organization under certain circumstances; requiring
15	elections to be held during certain time frame; providing for codification; providing an effective
16	date; and declaring an emergency.

18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
20	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 509.12 of Title 70, unless there
21	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
22	A. No existing employee organization established pursuant to
23	the provisions of Section 509.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes
24 2 -	shall continue to represent employees as defined in Section 509.2 or

Section 1-116 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes after December
31, 2021, except as provided for in this section.

B. 1. A school district board of education shall hold a secret
ballot election for all employees in any bargaining unit represented
by an existing employee organization to determine whether the
organization retains support of a majority of all employees in the
bargaining unit.

8 2. The school district board of education shall determine 9 whether elections shall be conducted in person, by mail, by 10 telephone, by Internet-based systems or by any other means 11 determined by the board of education to be fair, confidential and 12 reliable. The board of education shall allow employees in the 13 bargaining unit to cast ballots for a period of five (5) business 14 days.

15 3. The school district board of education may establish a fee 16 schedule, consistent with the provisions of Section 509.2 of Title 17 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, for employee organizations subject to 18 elections conducted pursuant to the provisions of this section for 19 the purpose of funding the election.

C. If a majority of all employees in the bargaining unit vote in favor of retaining the existing employee organization, the organization shall remain the representative of employees in the bargaining unit pursuant to the provisions of Section 509.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes. If a majority of all employees in the

<sup>1</sup> bargaining unit do not vote in favor of retaining the existing <sup>2</sup> employee organization, the school district board of education shall <sup>3</sup> no longer recognize the organization as the representative of <sup>4</sup> employees in the unit and the employees shall be unrepresented.

D. When an existing employee organization is no longer recognized, the terms of any pre-existing contract between the employee organization and the school district employees represented by the organization shall continue and remain in effect for the remaining contract term, except for any provisions involving in any manner the employee organization including but not limited to organization security, dues and fees, grievances and arbitration.

E. A school district board of education may recognize a new employee organization in accordance with the provisions of Section function 509.2 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, but the new employee organization may not be substantially similar to or affiliated with an employee organization that has lost recognition pursuant to the provisions of subsection C of this section for twelve (12) months from the date of the loss of recognition.

F. The school district board of education shall hold an election to certify majority support of existing employee organizations no earlier than August 1, 2021, and no later than December 1, 2021, and every odd-numbered year thereafter. Elections shall occur no earlier than August 1 and no later than December 1. SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
