6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to vaccines; requiring health care
8 provider to offer certain vaccines individually upon
9 request; directing promulgation of rules; providing
10 for codification; and providing an effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3170 of Title 63, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Upon request of a patient who is, or upon request of a parent or
16 legal guardian whose child or ward is, to be vaccinated against
17 measles, mumps and rubella, a health care provider shall offer each
18 individual vaccine as a separate shot. The patient or parent or
19 guardian shall have the right to request that each injection be
20 administered on different occasions. The State Commissioner of
21 Health shall promulgate rules to implement and enforce the
22 provisions of this section.
