SENATE BILL 1847

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to health care facilities; requiring certain signage; requiring the State Department of Health to create certain sign; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-714.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The administrator or appropriate authority of a hospital or other health care facility shall post, in a conspicuous location in each waiting room and each examination room, the sign created by the State Department of Health under subsection B of this section.

B. The State Department of Health shall create a standard sign containing information about immunization requirements for attendance of schools in this state and information about immunization exemptions. The Department shall make the sign available on the Department's website in a downloadable format.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
