6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to mental health and substance abuse
8 services; providing for certain consent by certain
9 minors; providing for codification; and providing an
effective date.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-328 of Title 43A, unless there
14 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

15 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a minor who is not
16 less than sixteen (16) years of age or is emancipated may consent to
17 outpatient mental health or substance abuse treatment, therapy,
18 counseling or other services by a mental health or substance abuse
19 services provider licensed in this state.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
