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11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2011, Section 1-527, is
13	amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1-527. Any physician who makes a diagnosis or treats a
15	case of a sexually transmitted infection (STI), and every
16	superintendent or manager of a hospital, dispensary or charitable or
17	penal institution in which there is a case of an STI, shall report
18	such case immediately, in writing , to or electronically:
19	1. To the director or designee of the city-county health
20	department, if in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County, who shall, in
21	turn, report such case to the State Commissioner of Health; or
22	2. Directly to the State Commissioner of Health, or the local
23	health officer if not in Oklahoma County or Tulsa County,
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1	in the same manner as other communicable diseases are reported, in
2	forms to be prescribed and furnished by the Commissioner.
3	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
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
