The seventh day of August of 17 each year is hereby established as "Purple Heart Day" in Oklahoma. 18 The Purple Heart, as established by George Washington in 1782 and 19 revived in 1932, is a decoration of honor awarded to members of the 20 Armed Forces and to United States citizens honorably wounded in 21 action. 22 All residents of this state are requested to devote some portion 23 of Purple Heart Day to recognizing and commemorating the recipients

of the Purple Heart who have demonstrated a commitment to fighting

1 for the ideals which have made this nation great, have served this 2 nation so valiantly, and are role models for all to emulate. 3 It is the intent of the Oklahoma Legislature that: 4 The Governor execute a proclamation each year in recognition 5 of Purple Heart Day; 6 2. The Secretary of Veterans Affairs encourage the observance 7 of Purple Heart Day with appropriate activities; and 8 3. Each local chapter of all veterans' organizations plan 9 special activities and events to honor the Purple Heart recipients 10 in that chapter; and 11 4. That the State of Oklahoma be designated as a Purple Heart 12 State in recognition of the many citizens of the state who have 13 earned the Purple Heart Medal as a result of being wounded while 14 engaged in combat with an enemy force. 15 SECTION 2.
