If no such board or commission oversees the agency, then the Governor shall submit the salary increase. No agency head shall submit his or her own salary increase to the Legislature. The Legislature may approve the submitted salary increase by the proper passage of a joint or concurrent resolution. Upon proper passage, the salary increase shall be authorized to commence.

- C. For the purposes of this section, "state agency" means any office, bureau, board, commission, counsel, unit, division, body, authority or institution of the executive branch of state government, excluding institutions within The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education or the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
