7 AS INTRODUCED

8 An Act relating to motor vehicles; prohibiting  
9 contracting for use of photo monitoring devices;  
10 defining term; providing for codification; and  
11 providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 11-226 of Title 47, unless there  
15 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 A. No state, county, municipal, or political subdivision may  
17 contract with any private corporation to provide for the use of any  
18 photo monitoring device to detect any red light violation.

19 B. As used in this section, the term "photo monitoring device"  
20 means a stationary, unmanned device used with a lighted traffic  
21 control device to detect a red light violation combined with a  
22 photographic identification of the vehicle which results in the  
23 issuance of a citation against the registrant, rather than the  
24 driver, of the vehicle.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
