1 common entryway or common indoor area with, any other enclosed 2 indoor workplace, including a restaurant. 3 B. On or before the effective date of this act, the Department 4 of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services shall develop and, 5 from time to time, update, a notice containing information on 6 substance abuse treatment services, helplines or other information 7 deemed by the Department to be relevant. The Department shall make 8 the notice available on its website. 9 C. Beginning January 1, 2020, all restaurants and bars shall 10 have posted, in a breakroom or other location where employees will 11 frequently see it, the notice created pursuant to subsection B of 12 this section. 13 SECTION 2.
