6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to school expenditures; prohibiting  
8 certain schools from using certain funds to provide  
9 for private extracurricular lessons; providing  
10 definition; providing exemption for certain teachers  
11 and other personnel contracted pursuant to certain  
12 law; providing for promulgation of rules; providing  
13 for codification; providing an effective date; and  
14 declaring an emergency.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 5-191 of Title 70, unless there  
18 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 A. A public school district, a charter school sponsored as  
20 provided for in Section 3-132 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes  
21 and a virtual charter school sponsored by the Statewide Virtual  
22 Charter School Board pursuant to Section 3-145.3 of Title 70 of the  
23 Oklahoma Statutes shall be prohibited from using its State Aid  
24 allocation or any other state-appropriated revenue to contract with  
an individual or business entity to provide private extracurricular  
lessons to students.

1 B. For the purposes of this section, "private extracurricular  
2 lessons" shall include but not be limited to:

- 3 1. Gymnastics lessons;
- 4 2. Music lessons; and
- 5 3. Athletic performance lessons.

6 C. The provisions of this section shall not apply to teachers  
7 contracted by a public school district pursuant to Section 6-101 of  
8 Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes or teachers or other personnel  
9 contracted by a charter school or a virtual charter school pursuant  
10 to Section 3-135 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

11 D. The State Board of Education and the Statewide Virtual  
12 Charter School Board shall promulgate rules necessary to implement  
13 the provisions of this act.

14 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

15 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
16 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
17 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
18 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
