SENATE BILL NO. 726

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Act; amending 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1800.9, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 22, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1800.9), which relates to application for licensure; providing for temporary trainee license; establishing procedure for issuance; stating requirements for certain license; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1800.9, as last amended by Section 5, Chapter 22, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2018, Section 1800.9), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1800.9. A. Upon receiving proper application, payment of the proper license fee, and certification of recommendation by the Alarm and Locksmith Industry Committee, the Commissioner of Labor shall issue a license to the applicant. The license shall be valid for a one-year term.

B. Renewal of a license shall not prohibit disciplinary proceedings for an act committed prior to the renewal.

1 C. The Commissioner may adopt a system under which licenses  
2 expire on various dates throughout the year. For any change in such  
3 expiration dates, license fees shall be prorated on an appropriate  
4 periodic basis.

5 D. Upon receiving proper application for a trainee license,  
6 payment of the proper license fee, and documentation required by the  
7 Alarm, Locksmith and Fire Sprinkler Industry Committee, whether such  
8 application is submitted in person, by mail or in an electronic  
9 format, the Commissioner of Labor shall issue a temporary trainee  
10 license to the applicant pending approval or denial of full  
11 licensure. The temporary trainee license shall be valid for ninety  
12 (90) days and such term may be extended for good cause not to exceed  
13 an additional ninety-day period. The person issued a temporary  
14 trainee license is required to work under the direct supervision of  
15 a licensed person or company. The temporary trainee license shall  
16 not be transferrable and shall be surrendered within ten (10) days  
17 to the Department of Labor upon issuance of a full license or notice  
18 of a denial of licensure.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

20 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
