SENATE BILL NO. 758

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to professions and occupations;
authorizing the State Board of Medical Licensure and
Supervision and the State Board of Osteopathic
Examiners to issue certain guidance; authorizing
Boards to take disciplinary action against certain
physicians; providing for codification; and declaring
an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 510.1 of Title 59, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Medical Licensure and Supervision is
hereby authorized to issue guidance to all allopathic physicians in
this state on the recommending of medical marijuana to patients.

B. The Board may take disciplinary action as provided for in
the Oklahoma Allopathic Medical and Surgical Licensure and
Supervision Act against any allopathic physician who willfully
violates or aids another in the willful violation of the provisions
of Section 420 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 638.1 of Title 59, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The State Board of Osteopathic Examiners is hereby authorized to issue guidance to all osteopathic physicians in this state on the recommending of medical marijuana to patients.

B. The Board may take disciplinary action as provided for in the Oklahoma Osteopathic Medicine Act against any osteopathic physician who willfully violates or aids another in the willful violation of the provisions of Section 420 et seq. of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
