AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to medical marijuana; prohibiting physician from taking certain actions; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A physician who recommends use of medical marijuana shall not:

1. Accept, solicit or offer any form of pecuniary remuneration from or to a caregiver, dispensary, processor, or commercial grower;
2. Offer a discount or any other thing of value to a patient who uses or agrees to use a particular caregiver or dispensary;
3. Examine a patient for the purposes of recommending medical marijuana at a location where medical marijuana is dispensed; or
4. Hold any economic interest in an enterprise that grows, transports, processes, or dispenses medical marijuana.

1 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
