AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to alcoholic beverage licenses; authorizing employer payment plan for employee alcohol licenses; authorizing payment plan; directing promulgation of rules; providing for recommendation of legislation; requiring employer to be qualified and request a payment plan; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-143.1 of Title 37A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, the Alcoholic Beverage Laws Enforcement (ABLE) Commission shall promulgate rules for employee license payment plans or may recommend changes in legislation as may be necessary to allow for large corporate employers to pay for its employee alcohol licenses through either a purchase card, national credit card, draw account or other method of corporate payment provided the employer is otherwise qualified under the standards established by rule and has requested that ABLE provide an employee license payment plan.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
