SENATE BILL NO. 825

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Nursing Home Care Act;
requiring pharmacists to take certain actions when
possible; allowing certain practitioners to take
certain actions; requiring certain label; providing
for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1950.10 of Title 63, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A pharmacist shall dilute, reconstitute and label medications
whenever possible. When not possible, a registered nurse or
Licensed Practical Nurse may reconstitute, dilute and label
medications. A distinctive, indelible, supplementary label shall be
affixed to the medication container when diluted or reconstituted
for other than immediate use. The label shall include the
following:

1. Resident's name;
2. Dosage and strength per unit/volume;

1 3. Pharmacist's or nurse's initials, as appropriate;

2 4. Expiration date; and

3 5. Date and time of dilution or reconstitution.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.

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
