AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to substance abuse services;  
directing the Department of Mental Health and  
Substance Abuse Services to initiate certain public-  
private partnership; providing for codification; and  
providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3-406.2 of Title 43A, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services  
shall initiate a public-private partnership with one or more  
substance abuse treatment providers for the purposes of identifying  
and obtaining federal funds to be used for inpatient treatment for  
substance abuse, and shall partner with the provider or providers to  
provide such services.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
