SENATE BILL NO. 935

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to hunting and fishing; requiring the Wildlife Conservation Commission to create a special use permit; providing land size restriction; providing terms of permit; exempting certain license requirements; stating price restriction for permit; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4-113.2 of Title 29, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall establish a five-day special use permit to be purchased by a landowner for a tract of land that is the size of three hundred fifty (350) acres or more.

B. The special use permit shall allow residents and nonresidents with the permission of the landowner to hunt and fish on the tract of land, and the individuals shall be exempt from hunting and fishing license requirements for the term that the special use permit is issued.

1 C. The term for the special use permit shall only be for
2 consecutive days.

3 D. The price of the special use permit shall not exceed One
4 Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
