HOUSE BILL 2143

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System (MKARNS); creating the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure Revolving Fund; providing for authorized sources of revenue; providing for expenditure of funds and prescribing procedures related thereto; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1141 of Title 82, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to be designated the "McClellan-Kerr Arkansas River Navigation System Infrastructure Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the Oklahoma Department of Transportation from appropriations, dedicated revenues, federal funds or other sources authorized by

1 law. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby
2 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Oklahoma
3 Department of Transportation for the purpose of repairing or
4 constructing assets which are part of the McClellan-Kerr Arkansas
5 River Navigation System (MKARNS) located in the State of Oklahoma
6 which are essential to the safe and efficient operation of such
7 system. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants
8 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
9 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise
10 Services for approval and payment.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

12 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
13 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
14 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
15 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
