6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to security guards; amending 59 O.S.
8 2011, Section 1750.10A, which relates to the Oklahoma
9 Security Guard and Private Investigator Act;
10 establishing active shooter training requirement for
11 armed security guards; providing list of course
12 requirements; authorizing armed security guards to
13 respond to active shooter crisis situations upon
14 successful completion of training course; directing
15 the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training
16 to include active shooter training in armed security
17 guard course; and providing an effective date.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1750.10A, is
16 amended to read as follows:

17 Section 1750.10A A. The firearm training for armed security
18 guards may include the reduction targets for weapons fired at fifty
19 (50) feet to simulate weapons fired at seventy-five (75) feet in
20 indoor ranges. All indoor ranges for this training shall have a
21 minimum of three firing lanes and be approved by the Council on Law
22 Enforcement Education and Training.

23 B. The training for armed security guards shall include a
24 course on how to prepare for and respond to active shooter crisis

1 situations. The course shall provide training on the following
2 subjects:

3 1. How to respond and what actions to take when confronted with
4 an active shooter;

5 2. How to assist responding law enforcement officials;

6 3. How to recognize potential workplace violence indicators;

7 4. How to prevent and prepare for potential active shooter
8 incidents; and

9 5. How to manage the consequences of an active shooter
10 incident.

11 Upon successful completion of active shooter training, armed
12 security guard licensees shall be permitted to respond to active
13 shooter crisis situations.

14 C. The Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training shall
15 include in its required course of study for armed security guards
16 active shooter training as provided in subsection B of this section.

17 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
