If the action be brought 22 without such endorsement, the complaining witness must file with the 23 court a bond to be approved by the court in a sum not less than 24 Fifty Dollars (\$50.00), conditioned to pay all costs, and the county

    unless the complaint be first so endorsed by the district attorney.

        B. A misdemeanor warrant shall not be effective for an amount

    of time greater than the statute of limitations for the underlying

    crime pursuant to Section 152 of this title. Every misdemeanor

    warrant that is issued shall include a date of expiration; provided,
 7
    the date of expiration shall be no longer than three (3) years after
 8
    the date of issuance after which point the misdemeanor warrant shall
 9
    no longer be valid. This provision shall be retroactively applied
10
    to all outstanding misdemeanor warrants.

        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2019.
