HOUSE BILL 2859

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health; requiring State Department of Health to provide hospitals with educational and training material on safe sleep practices for newborns; requiring hospitals to make material available to new parents; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-547 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The State Department of Health shall provide each licensed hospital, as defined in Section 1-701 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, educational and training materials for new parents on safe sleep practices for newborns. The hospital shall make the educational and training material available to the new parents prior to discharge of the newborn from the hospital.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
