6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to prisons and reformatories;  
8 granting compensation increase to personnel meeting  
9 certain conditions; conditioning eligibility for  
10 increase on job classification and employment  
11 facility; establishing calculation of compensation  
12 increase; providing for reduction of increase under  
13 certain conditions; providing for codification;  
14 providing an effective date; and declaring an  
15 emergency.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

17 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
18 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 528.8 of Title 57, unless there  
19 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

20 A. Effective July 1, 2020, all personnel of the Department of  
21 Corrections employed by the state on the last working day of June  
22 2019:

23 1. At a facility listed in subsection B of this section, or  
24 as a probation and parole officer; and

2. With a job classification listed in subsection C of this  
section,

1 shall, subject to reduction as provided in subsection D of this  
2 section, be awarded an increase of Two Dollars (\$2.00) per hour over  
3 their current hourly wage, or an equivalent amount if not receiving  
4 an hourly wage.

5 B. Except as otherwise provided in this act, the compensation  
6 increase described in subsection A of this section shall only be  
7 applicable to personnel assigned to the following facilities:

- 9 2. Clara Waters Community Corrections Center;
- 10 3. Dick Conner Correctional Center;
- 11 4. Dr. Eddie Warrior Correctional Center;
- 12 5. Enid Community Corrections Center;

- 14 7. Jackie Brannon Correctional Center;
- 15 8. James Crabtree Correctional Center;
- 16 9. Jess Dunn Correctional Center;
- 17 10. Jim E. Hamilton Correctional Center;
- 18 11. John H. Lilley Correctional Center;
- 19 12. Joseph Harp Correctional Center;
- 20 13. Kate Barnard Correctional Center;
- 21 14. Lawton Community Corrections Center;
- 22 15. Lexington Assessment and Reception Center;
- 23 16. Mabel Bassett Correctional Center;
- 24 17. Mack Alford Correctional Center;

- 1 18. Northeast Oklahoma Correctional Center;
- 2 19. North Fork Correctional Center;
- 3 20. Oklahoma State Penitentiary;
- 4 21. Oklahoma State Reformatory;
- 5 22. Oklahoma City Community Corrections Center;
- 6 23. Union City Community Corrections Center; or
- 7 24. William S. Key Correctional Center.

8 C. The compensation increase described in subsection A of this  
9 section shall only be applicable to personnel with the following job  
10 classifications:

- 11 1. Accountant;
- 12 2. Accounting Technician;
- 13 3. Administrative Assistant;
- 14 4. Administrative Programs Officer;
- 15 5. Administrative Specialist;
- 16 6. Administrative Technician;
- 17 7. Alcohol and Drug Counselor;
- 18 8. Business Manager;
- 19 9. Business Process Analyst;
- 20 10. Chaplain;
- 21 11. Chief Dental Officer;
- 22 12. Community Corrections Center Director;
- 23 13. Correctional Activities Officer;
- 24 14. Correctional Training Officer;

- 1 15. Deputy Warden;
- 2 16. Director of Classification/Population;
- 3 17. Electrician;
- 4 18. Executive Secretary;
- 5 19. Facility Classification Manager;
- 6 20. Fleet Specialist;
- 7 21. Human Resources Management Specialist;
- 8 22. Maintenance Technician;
- 9 23. Mechanical Systems Technician;
- 10 24. Offender Program Coordinator;
- 11 25. Physical Plant Operator;
- 12 26. Population Coordinator;
- 13 27. Probation and Parole Officer;
- 14 28. Program Facilitator;
- 15 29. Program Manager;
- 16 30. Secretary;
- 17 31. Substance Abuse Program Coordinator;
- 18 32. Temporary;
- 19 33. Transition Coordinator;
- 20 34. Warden; or
- 21 35. Wastewater Treatment Operator.

22 D. The compensation increase authorized by subsection A of this  
23 section shall be reduced by the amount of compensation increase an  
24 otherwise eligible individual received pursuant to:

1 1. Enrolled Senate Bill No. 1045 of the 1st Session of the 57th  
2 Oklahoma Legislature; and

3 2. Enrolled House Bill No. 2771 of the 1st Session of the 57th  
4 Oklahoma Legislature.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

6 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
7 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby  
8 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
9 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
