7	An Act relating to campaign finance and financial disclosure; amending Sections 12 and 18, Chapter 313,
8 9	O.S.L. 2014 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019, Sections 56-102 and 56-108), which relate to the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying
10	definition; amending Sections 3, 4, 5 and 8, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, Sections
11	138.12, 138.13, 138.14 and 138.17), which relate to the County Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying definition; removing notary
12	requirements; amending Sections 22 and 28, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Sections 2-111
13	and 2-117), which relate to the Technology Center District and Independent School District Campaign
14	Finance and Financial Disclosure Act; modifying definition; amending Section 31, Chapter 313, O.S.L.
15	2014 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 4261), which relates to the Ethics Commission Act; modifying forms
16	necessary for compliance; authorizing Ethics Commission to develop certain online reporting
17	processes; and providing an effective date.
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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
21	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 12, Chapter 313, O.S.L
22	2014 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 56-102), is amended to read as
23	follows:
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Section 56-102. A. Definitions of terms used in the Municipal
 Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as
 those terms are defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission
 promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma
 Constitution, unless otherwise provided herein.

B. As used in the Municipal Campaign Finance and Financial7 Disclosure Act:

8 1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed 9 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the 10 election of a specific candidate to municipal office, whose name as 11 it will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the 12 committee;

13 2. "Municipal office" means any elective municipal office for 14 which Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the secretary of the 15 county election board as required by Sections 16-109 and 16-110 of 16 Title 11 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title; and

3. "Municipal political committee" means any committee composed
of one two or more persons whose purpose includes the election or
defeat of one or more candidates for municipal office, or questions
submitted to a vote of the people at a municipal election, but which
is not required to register with the Ethics Commission or the
Federal Election Commission.

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1 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY Section 18, Chapter 313, O.S.L.
2 2014 (11 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 56-108), is amended to read as
3 follows:

4 Section 56-108. All candidates for municipal office and all 5 elected municipal officers shall be required to file a statement of financial interests with the municipal clerk subject to the same 6 7 requirements as set forth for candidates for state office required to file statements of financial interests filed with the Ethics 8 9 Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant 10 to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, including 11 but not limited to time for filing and contents.

SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 3, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 138.12), is amended to read as follows:

Section 138.12 A. Definitions of terms used in the County Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as those terms are defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, unless otherwise provided herein.

B. As used in the County Campaign Finance and Financial
Disclosure Act:

22 1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed 23 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the

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election of a specific candidate to county office, whose name as it
 will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the committee;

2. "County office" means any elective county office for which
4 Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the secretary of the county
5 election board as required by Section 5-103 of Title 26 of the
6 Oklahoma Statutes; and

3. "County political committee" means any committee composed of
one two or more persons whose purpose includes the election or
defeat of one or more candidates for county office, or questions
submitted to a vote of the people at a county election, but which is
not required to register with the Ethics Commission or the Federal
Election Commission.

SECTION 4. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 138.13), is amended to read as follows:

16 Section 138.13 Each campaign committee shall file a notarized 17 statement of organization with the county election board subject to 18 the same requirements as set forth for candidate committees for 19 state office to file statements of organization with the Ethics 20 Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant 21 to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, including 22 but not limited to time for filing and contents, except as otherwise 23 provided in the County Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure 24 Act. The statement of organization shall be accompanied by a check

drawn upon the campaign committee's account in the amount of Fifty
Dollars (\$50.00) as a nonrefundable processing fee to be deposited
in the County Election Board Special Depository Account.
Expenditures from such fees may be made by the secretary of the
county election board for any lawful purpose.

6 SECTION 5. AMENDATORY Section 5, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 7 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 138.14), is amended to read as 8 follows:

9 Section 138.14 Every county political committee shall file a 10 notarized statement of organization with the county election board subject to the same requirements as set forth for political 11 12 committees required to file statements of organization with the Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated 13 14 pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, 15 including but not limited to time for filing and contents. 16 AMENDATORY SECTION 6. Section 8, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 17 2014 (19 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 138.17), is amended to read as 18 follows:

Section 138.17 All candidates for county office and all elected county officers shall be required to file a notarized statement of financial interests with the county election board subject to the same requirements as set forth for statements of financial interests filed with the Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics

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Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the
 Oklahoma Constitution.

3 SECTION 7. AMENDATORY Section 22, Chapter 313, O.S.L.
4 2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 2-111), is amended to read as
5 follows:

6 Section 2-111. A. Definitions of terms used in the Technology 7 Center District and Independent School District Campaign Finance and 8 Financial Disclosure Act shall be the same as those terms are 9 defined in Rules of the Ethics Commission promulgated pursuant to 10 Section 3 of Article XXIX of the Oklahoma Constitution, unless 11 otherwise provided herein.

B. As used in the Technology Center District and IndependentSchool District Campaign Finance and Disclosure Act:

14 1. "Campaign committee" means a committee which may be composed 15 of one or more persons the purpose of which is to support the 16 election of a specific candidate to school district office, whose 17 name as it will appear on the ballot shall appear in the name of the 18 committee;

19 2. "School district" means a technology center district or an 20 independent school district;

3. "School district office" means any elective school district office for which Declarations of Candidacy are filed with the secretary of the county election board as required by Section 13A-105 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

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4. "School district political committee" means any committee
 composed of one two or more persons whose purpose includes the
 election or defeat of one or more candidates for school district
 office, or questions submitted to a vote of the people at a school
 <u>district election</u>, but which is not required to register with the
 Ethics Commission or the Federal Election Commission.

7 SECTION 8. AMENDATORY Section 28, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 8 2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 2-117), is amended to read as 9 follows:

10 Section 2-117. All candidates for school district office and 11 all elected school district officers shall be required to file a 12 statement of financial interests with the school district clerk 13 subject to the same requirements as set forth for candidates for 14 state office required to file statements of financial interests 15 filed with the Ethics Commission under Rules of the Ethics 16 Commission promulgated pursuant to Section 3 of Article XXIX of the 17 Oklahoma Constitution, including but not limited to time for filing 18 and contents.

SECTION 9. AMENDATORY Section 31, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 20 2014 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 4261), is amended to read as 21 follows:

Section 4261. The Ethics Commission shall design all forms required for compliance with the County Campaign Finance and Financial Disclosure Act, the Municipal Campaign Finance and

1	Financial Disclosure Act and the Technology Center District and
2	Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial
3	Disclosure Act. Such forms shall be made available in electronic
4	form on the Commission's Internet website. <u>Additionally, the Ethics</u>
5	Commission shall develop online reporting processes for the
6	reporting of information required by the Municipal Campaign Finance
7	and Financial Disclosure Act, the County Campaign Finance and
8	Financial Disclosure Act and the Technology Center District and
9	Independent School District Campaign Finance and Financial
10	Disclosure Act, as funds are available, to develop and maintain
11	online reporting.
12	SECTION 10. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
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
