15	Section 5-405. A. Except as otherwise provided, no person may
16	hunt, kill, capture or otherwise take or destroy any furbearer,
17	except from the first day of December to the last day of February,
18	both dates inclusive.
19	B. Any person who takes a pelt or pelts during the season shall
20	have ten (10) working days after the close of the season to sell or
21	dispose of the pelts or to provide written notification to the
22	Department of Wildlife Conservation that the person intends to hold
23	the pelts for later sale. Written notification shall be made on a
24	form prescribed by the Department.
