HOUSE BILL 3346

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring certain schools to include certain information on pupil identification cards; stating intent of the Legislature to require institutions of higher education to include certain information on student identification cards; allowing schools and institutions of higher education to issue unused pupil and student identification cards; providing applicability; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1210.200A of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning July 1, 2021, a public school, including a charter school or a private school that serves any pupils in seventh grade to twelfth grade and issues pupil identification cards, shall have printed on either side of the pupil identification cards the telephone number described in paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either side of the pupil identification cards the

1 telephone numbers described in paragraphs 2 and 3 of this
2 subsection:

3 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention
4 Lifeline, 1-800-273-8255;

5 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
6 to 741741; and

7 3. A local suicide prevention hotline telephone number.

8 B. It is the intent of the Legislature that, beginning July 1,
9 2021, a public or private institution of higher education that
10 issues student identification cards may have printed on either side
11 of the student identification cards the telephone number described
12 in paragraph 1 of this subsection and may have printed on either
13 side of the student identification cards the telephone numbers
14 described in paragraphs 2, 3 and 4 of this subsection:

15 1. The telephone number for the National Suicide Prevention
16 Lifeline, 1-800-273-8255;

17 2. The Crisis Text Line, which can be accessed by texting HOME
18 to 741741;

19 3. The campus police or security telephone number or, if the
20 campus does not have a campus police or security telephone number,
21 the local nonemergency telephone number; and

22 4. A local suicide prevention hotline telephone number.

23 C. As of January 1, 2021, if a school subject to the
24 requirements of subsection A of this section, or a public or private

1 institution of higher education subject to the requirements of
2 subsection B of this section, has a supply of unissued pupil or
3 student identification cards that do not comply with the
4 requirements of subsections A and B of this section, as applicable,
5 the school or the public or private institution of higher education
6 shall issue those pupil or student identification cards until that
7 supply is depleted.

8 D. Subsections A and B of this section shall apply to a pupil
9 or student identification card issued for the first time to a pupil
10 or student, and to a pupil or student identification card issued to
11 replace a damaged or lost pupil or student identification card.

12 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
