8	Janie's Gift Act; defining terms; providing for payment of funeral expenses by the State Department
9	of Health; directing the State Department of Health to promulgate rules; establishing the Janie's Gift
10	Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2219.1 of Title 63, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Janie's Gift
19	Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2219.2 of Title 63, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	A. As used in the Janie's Gift Act:

- 1. "Anatomical gift" means a donation of all or part of a human body to take effect after the donor's death for the purpose of transplantation, therapy, research, or education; and
- 2. "Donor" means an individual whose body or part is the subject of an anatomical gift.

- B. The State Department of Health shall pay the cremation and associated costs for conveyance of the remains to a family member or responsible party of the donor with funds from the Janie's Gift Revolving Fund if:
- 1. A donor elects to make an anatomical gift pursuant to Section 2200.5A of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes;
 - 2. Upon death, the anatomical gift was successful;
- 3. The donor does not have sufficient property or means to pay for funeral expenses; and
- 4. Application is made by a surviving family member or responsible party of the donor.
- C. The State Department of Health shall promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section to include the development and maintenance of an application for the payment of funeral expenses on the Department's website.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2219.3 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Each individual taxpayer required to file a state income tax return who desires to contribute to the Janie's Gift Revolving Fund, as created in Section 4 of this act, may designate the contribution on the appropriate income tax form. The contribution shall not increase or decrease the income or liability of the taxpayer and may be made by reducing the income tax refund of a taxpayer by the amount designated or by accepting additional payment from the taxpayer by the amount designated, whichever is appropriate.

- B. 1. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall include on each state individual income tax return form for tax years beginning after

 December 31, 2021, an opportunity for the taxpayer to donate for the benefit of the Janie's Gift Revolving Fund. The instructions accompanying the income tax form shall be provided to the Oklahoma

 Tax Commission by the State Department of Health and shall contain a description of the purpose for which the Janie's Gift Revolving Fund was established and information on the use of monies from the income tax contribution.
- 2. Taxpayers who are entitled to refunds shall have the refunds reduced by the amount designated by the taxpayer. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall annually determine the total amount designated plus the amount received in excess payments and shall report the total amount to the Office of the State Treasurer. The State Treasurer shall credit the total amount to the Janie's Gift Revolving Fund created in Section 4 of this act at the earliest possible time.

C. The incremental cost of administration of contributions shall be paid out of the fund to the Oklahoma Tax Commission from amounts received pursuant to this section before funds are expended for the purposes of the fund.

- SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2219.4 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- A. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated the "Janie's Gift Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of Health from:
- 1. All state monies appropriated for the purpose of implementing the provisions of the Janie's Gift Act;
- 2. A one-time transfer of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from the Unclaimed Property Fund if approved by the Legislature pursuant to an appropriation; and
- 3. All monies collected by the Tax Commission through donations pursuant to Section 3 of this act.
- B. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State

 Department of Health for the purpose of administering the Janie's Gift Act. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by
