7 An Act relating to counties and county officers;
8 authorizing boards of county commissioners to enter
9 into contracts for security guard services; requiring
certain licensing; providing for codification; and
providing an effective date.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

13 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 747 of Title 19, unless there is
15 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

16 The board of county commissioners of each county may enter into
17 contracts with private security agencies or security guards for
18 security guard services and the security of any building owned by
19 the county and any other buildings where the sheriff is required to
20 provide security detail on prisoners inside the building. The
21 contracts may be for a period not to exceed a time as determined by
22 the commissioners subject to annual appropriations by the county
23 excise board. Security guard agencies or security guards providing
24 security for county-owned buildings shall be licensed pursuant to

1 the Oklahoma Security Guard and Private Investigator Act permitting
2 the holder to perform the functions of a security guard, armed
3 security guard or security agency.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
