14	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132.8 of Title 47, unless there
16	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
17	A. Beginning November 1, 2020, the Oklahoma Tax Commission
18	shall levy a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) upon every vehicle
19	registration, in addition to other vehicle registration fees as
20	specified by law. The fee shall accrue and shall be collectable
21	upon each vehicle under the same circumstances and shall be payable
22	in the same manner and time as apply to vehicle registrations under

the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee

shall be paid in full for the current year at the time any vehicle is first registered in a calendar year.

- B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section shall be transferred each month to the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET) for deposit in the Peace Officer Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 3311.7 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.
- C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this section shall be required before licensing or registration of any vehicles.
- 11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
