HOUSE BILL 3375

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to motor vehicles; levying a fee on vehicle registration; directing the fee be transferred to the Council of Law Enforcement Education and Training Peace Officer Revolving Fund; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1132.8 of Title 47, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Beginning November 1, 2020, the Oklahoma Tax Commission shall levy a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) upon every vehicle registration, in addition to other vehicle registration fees as specified by law. The fee shall accrue and shall be collectable upon each vehicle under the same circumstances and shall be payable in the same manner and time as apply to vehicle registrations under the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act; provided, the fee

1 shall be paid in full for the current year at the time any vehicle  
2 is first registered in a calendar year.

3 B. Revenue from the fee levied in subsection A of this section  
4 shall be transferred each month to the Council on Law Enforcement  
5 Education and Training (CLEET) for deposit in the Peace Officer  
6 Revolving Fund created pursuant to Section 3311.7 of Title 70 of the  
7 Oklahoma Statutes.

8 C. The collection and payment of the fee specified in this  
9 section shall be required before licensing or registration of any  
10 vehicles.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
