- 7 2. The number of students who receive payments or benefits from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs; 8
  - The rate of retention and average age of the students who are veterans;
- 11 4. The most common areas of study for students who are veterans;
  - 5. Any information necessary to determine the impact of policy changes on the number of students who are veterans who are enrolled in The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education;
  - 6. The number of students who are veterans who graduated during the immediate preceding academic year; and
  - The efforts of each institution to retain and graduate students who are veterans through retention and other related programs.
- 21 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
