HOUSE BILL 3744

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring teacher or educational consultant to be a certified teacher; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.2a of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Any person acting as a teacher or educational consultant shall hold a valid teacher certificate issued by and in accordance with the rules of the State Board of Education.

B. For purposes of this section, a "teacher or educational consultant" means a person providing one-on-one consultation, support or advising services to a teacher inside the classroom, including, but not limited to, educational techniques. A teacher or

educational consultant shall not mean a mentor teacher as defined in
paragraph 11 of Section 6-182 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
