6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to memorial highways and bridges;  
8 designating the WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier  
9 Sgt. Robert James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge;  
10 designating the Keith N. Cantrell, PFC U.S. Army  
11 Memorial Bridge; designating the Paul Blevins, Jr.  
and Michael Rogers Memorial Highway; designating the  
12 Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran Memorial Bridge;  
13 providing for codification; and providing an  
14 effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
17 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.308 of Title 69, unless  
18 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

19 The bridge over Elk Creek on State Highway 9 located  
20 approximately one (1) mile west of Hobart in Kiowa County shall be  
21 designated as the "WWII Doolittle Raider - Bombardier Sgt. Robert  
22 James "R.J." Stephens Memorial Bridge". The Department of  
23 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing that  
24 name to be placed on the bridge.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.309 of Title 69, unless  
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 The bridge over Flat Creek on State Highway 34 located  
5 approximately one-half mile (0.5) north of West Madison Avenue near  
6 the town of Carter in Beckham County shall be designated as the  
7 "Keith N. Cantrell, PFC U.S. Army Memorial Bridge". The Department  
8 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers bearing  
9 that name to be placed on the bridge.

10 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.310 of Title 69, unless  
12 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 The section of State Highway 82 beginning at the intersection of  
14 U.S. Highway 62 and extending southeasterly to the intersection of  
15 East Flournory Road south of Tahlequah in Cherokee County shall be  
16 designated as the "Paul Blevins, Jr. and Michael Rogers Memorial  
17 Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable  
18 permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the highway.

19 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
20 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1698.311 of Title 69, unless  
21 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

22 The bridge over Muddy Boggy Creek on State Highway 43 located  
23 approximately one (1) mile east of the town of Coalgate in Coal  
24 County shall be designated as the "Stiles Brothers Vietnam Veteran

1 Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause  
2 suitable permanent markers bearing that name to be placed on the  
3 bridge.

4 SECTION 5. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
