17	Section 3-403. A. A licensee is authorized to:
18	1. Engage in the growth and cultivation of industrial hemp for
19	agricultural plant research purposes; and
20	2. Upon approval by the United States Department of Agriculture
21	of the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp Program, engage in the growth,
22	cultivation, handling or processing of industrial hemp.
23	B. The activities performed under the Oklahoma Industrial Hemp
24	Program shall not subject the persons participating in the program
