determine areas for improvement;

1 | 3. Analyze population growth and decline in the state;

- 4. Examine the access to health care in rural counties;
- 5. Work and develop relationships with other task forces, committees or organizations that are pursuing initiatives or studies similar to the purpose and duties outlined in this section; and
- 6. Collaborate with, serve as a resource to and receive input from health care providers and health care facilities in rural counties.
- C. The Task Force shall consist of the following seven (7)
 members:
 - 1. The Governor shall appoint the executive director;
 - 2. The Speaker of the House of Representatives shall appoint:
 - a representative of the Rural Health Network of Oklahoma or similar organization,
 - b. a representative of the State Department of Health, and
 - c. a state representative; and
 - 3. The President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall appoint:
 - a. a representative of the Office of Primary Care and Rural Health Development,
 - b. a representative of the Oklahoma Office of Rural Health, and
 - c. a state senator.

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- D. The appointing authorities shall make their initial appointments to the Task Force no later than January 1, 2021.

 E. Each member of the Task Force shall serve without compensation.

 F. The executive director shall call the meetings and notify
 - F. The executive director shall call the meetings and notify the members of each meeting being called at least seven (7) days in advance.
 - G. Meetings shall be held as often as the executive director deems necessary, but not less than four times per calendar year. A quorum for the transaction of business consists of four members of the Task Force.
 - H. Members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation but shall be allowed reimbursement for expenses pursuant to the State Travel Reimbursement Act.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
