HOUSE BILL 3796

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to schools; requiring minimum planning or preparation and consultation time for elementary school classroom teachers; requiring minimum planning or preparation and consultation time for secondary school classroom teachers; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 6-101.9 of Title 70, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A minimum of two hundred (200) minutes of scheduled time shall be provided each week for each elementary school classroom teacher for individual planning or preparation and consultation.

B. A minimum of two hundred twenty-five (225) minutes of scheduled time shall be provided each week for each secondary school classroom teacher for individual planning or preparation and consultation during the instructional day, unless otherwise voluntarily agreed in writing between the teacher and the school

1 district, with a stipend being provided to any teacher who forgoes  
2 planning time.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.  
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
