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14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
15	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
16	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4501 of Title 68, unless there
17	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
18	This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Oklahoma Remote
19	Quality Jobs Incentive Act".
20	SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
21	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4502 of Title 68, unless there
22	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
23	It is the intent of the Legislature that:
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The State of Oklahoma provide appropriate incentives to
 attract growth industries and sectors that employ remote workers to
 Oklahoma through a policy of rewarding businesses with a highly
 skilled, knowledge-based workforce;

5 2. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce and the Oklahoma Tax
6 Commission implement the provisions of this act and exercise all
7 powers as authorized in this act. The exercise of powers conferred
8 by this act shall be deemed and held to be the performance of
9 essential public purposes; and

Nothing herein shall be construed to constitute a guarantee or assumption by the State of Oklahoma of any debt of any individual, company, corporation or association nor to authorize the credit of the State of Oklahoma to be given, pledged or loaned to any individual, company, corporation or association.

SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4503 of Title 68, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in the Oklahoma Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Act: 19 1. "Basic industry" means an establishment that attracts remote 20 workers to the state whose purpose is to increase the state's 21 population may receive rebates on the remote workers provided that 22 the remote workers meet the wage and health insurance requirements 23 in state and provide evidence of such to the proxy establishment;

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1 2. "New direct job" shall include full-time-equivalent 2 employment in this state of remote workers who are employed by an establishment other than the proxy establishment which has qualified 3 4 to receive incentive payments for attracting remote workers to the 5 state. Such jobs held by remote workers did not exist in this state prior to the date of approval by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce 6 7 of the application of the proxy establishment. A job shall be deemed to exist in this state prior to approval of an application if 8 9 the activities and functions for which the particular job exists 10 have been ongoing at any time within six (6) months prior to such 11 approval;

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- 3. "Proxy establishment" means:

13 a. a public trust which:

14 is organized and existing under Section 176 of (1)15 Title 60 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the benefit 16 of a geographic area which includes a city or 17 county or some combination thereof, and 18 (2) benefits a geographic area where new direct jobs 19 which meet the requirements of the Oklahoma 20 Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Act are created by 21 an establishment, other than the proxy 22 establishment, which is a branch of the Armed 23 Forces of the United States, or

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b. an establishment which facilitates the attraction of remote workers to the State of Oklahoma; and

4. "Remote worker" refers to a work flexibility arrangement
under which an employee performs the duties and responsibilities of
such employee's position, and other authorized activities, from an
approved work site other than the location from which the employee
would otherwise work, which shall not be located within the physical
boundaries of the State of Oklahoma.

9 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4504 of Title 68, unless there 11 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A proxy establishment that facilitates the attraction of 12 13 remote workers to the State of Oklahoma which meets the 14 qualifications specified in the Oklahoma Remote Quality Jobs 15 Incentive Act may receive quarterly incentive payments for a ten-16 quarter period. The amount of such payments shall be equal to the 17 net benefit rate multiplied by the actual gross payroll of new 18 direct jobs for a calendar quarter as verified by the Oklahoma 19 Employment Security Commission.

B. In order to qualify to receive incentive payments as
authorized by the Oklahoma Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Act, a
proxy establishment shall be required to:

1. Have an annual gross payroll for new direct jobs projected
by the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to equal or exceed One

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Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) within one (1)
year of the first complete calendar quarter following the start
date; and

4 2. Have a number of full-time-equivalent employees working an
5 average of thirty (30) or more hours per week in the new direct jobs
6 equal to or in excess of eighty percent (80%) of the total number of
7 new direct jobs.

8 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 9 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4505 of Title 68, unless there 10 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

11 There is hereby created within the State Treasury a special fund 12 for the Oklahoma Tax Commission to be designated the "Oklahoma 13 Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Payment Fund". The Oklahoma Tax 14 Commission is hereby authorized and directed to withhold a portion 15 of the taxes levied and collected pursuant to Section 2355 of Title 16 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes for deposit into the fund. The amount 17 deposited shall equal the sum of an amount determined by multiplying 18 the net benefit rate provided by the Department of Commerce by the 19 gross payroll as determined pursuant to the provisions of this act. 20 All of the amounts deposited in such fund shall be used and expended 21 by the Tax Commission solely for the purposes and in the amounts 22 authorized by the Oklahoma Remote Quality Jobs Incentive Act. The 23 liability of the State of Oklahoma to make the incentive payments

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under this act shall be limited to the balance contained in the fund
 created by this section.
 SECTION 6. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.

SECTION 7. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
