L6	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
L7	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.1 of Title 63, unless
18	there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
L9	The Commissioner of Health, in collaboration with the Office of

21	Sickle Cell Alliance and Advisory Committee to raise awareness of
22	sickle cell disease and sickle cell trait.
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SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.2 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. The Advisory Committee shall study and advise the State

 Department of Health on implementing policies to improve the quality

 and longevity of life for individuals with sickle cell disease.
- B. The Commissioner may assign tasks to the Advisory Committee to accomplish the purposes of this act.
- SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.3 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
- The Advisory Committee shall be composed of the following members appointed by the Commissioner of Health:
- 1. Two members from community-based organizations with experience addressing the needs of individuals with sickle cell disease:
 - 2. One physician specializing in adult hematology;
 - 3. One physician specializing in pediatric hematology;
- 4. Two members of the public, each of whom either has sickle cell disease or is a parent of a person with sickle cell disease or trait;
 - 5. One representative of a health-related institution; and
 - 6. One representative from the Oklahoma Health Care Authority.

SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.4 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Commissioner of Health shall provide administrative support services at the request of the Advisory Committee.

SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.5 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

- A. The Advisory Committee shall elect a presiding officer from among its membership.
- B. The Advisory Committee shall meet at the call of the presiding officer.
- C. The Advisory Committee shall hold its first meeting not later than July 1, 2020.
- SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.6 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

An Advisory Committee member is not entitled to compensation for service on the Advisory Committee but is entitled to reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in performing Advisory Committee duties. The Advisory Committee may accept gifts, grants and donations to pay for those expenses.

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1 SECTION 7. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.7 of Title 63, unless 3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 4 Not later than December 1 of each year, the Advisory Committee 5 shall prepare and submit to the Governor and the Legislature an annual written report that summarizes the Advisory Committee's work 6 7 and includes any recommended actions or policy changes endorsed by 8 the Advisory Committee. 9 SECTION 8. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified 10 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-285.8 of Title 63, unless 11 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows: 12 The Sickle Cell Alliance and Advisory Committee shall cease to 13 exist on June 30, 2023. 14 SECTION 9.
