HOUSE BILL 4048

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; amending 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3909, as amended by Section 1009, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3909), which relates to the Oklahoma Sunset Law; modifying one-year period for ceasing affairs; repealing 74 O.S. 2011, Sections 3903, 3904, 3905, 3906, 3907, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2016 and 3908 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3907), which relate to termination of certain statutory entities; removing obsolete language; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2011, Section 3909, as amended by Section 1009, Chapter 304, O.S.L. 2012 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3909), is amended to read as follows:

Section 3909. A. Except as otherwise provided by law, any statutory entity ~~listed in Sections 3903 through 3908 of this title~~ created or re-created in accordance with the provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law which is terminated shall have a period of one (1) year after its termination date for the purpose of ceasing its affairs and termination shall not reduce or otherwise limit the

1 powers, duties, or functions of said entity. Upon the expiration of
2 the one-year period, the entity and its personnel positions shall be
3 abolished.

4 B. Except as otherwise provided by law, one (1) year after the
5 termination date of a statutory entity, the State Treasurer shall
6 transfer all funds of that entity to the General Revenue Fund. All
7 debts of that entity shall be paid by the State Treasurer from the
8 funds of that statutory entity. All equipment, files, fixtures,
9 furniture, and supplies of the terminated entity shall be
10 transferred to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to
11 be stored or disposed of as specified by law. Any other outstanding
12 obligations or functions remaining to be performed after termination
13 of an entity shall be performed by the Office of Management and
14 Enterprise Services until provisions are made for such obligations
15 or functions by the Legislature.

16 SECTION 2. REPEALER 74 O.S. 2011, Sections 3903, 3904,
17 3905, 3906, 3907, as amended by Section 12, Chapter 269, O.S.L. 2016
18 and 3908 (74 O.S. Supp. 2019, Section 3907), are hereby repealed.

19 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective November 1, 2020.
