17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:	
18	SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION AND REDESIGNATION The amount	
19	of Two Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$2,600,000.00) of the	
20	original appropriation of Five Million Six Hundred Thousand Dollars	
21	(\$5,600,000.00), appropriated to the Office of Management and	
22	Enterprise Services by Section 132, Chapter 146, O.S.L. 2018, from	
23	any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of	
24	the State Treasury to reconcile costs associated with the funding of	

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state pension systems, is hereby reappropriated and redesignated to
the Office of Management and Enterprise Services to perform duties
imposed upon the Office by law. If, on the date this act is
approved, any of the amount originally appropriated, as adjusted by
expenditures, encumbrances and transfers, results in an unencumbered
balance less than the reappropriated and redesignated amount, that
reappropriated and redesignated amount is reduced to the
unencumbered amount.

SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Postal Service Revolving Fund (Fund 231), the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Management and Enterprise Services by law.

SECTION 3. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Registration of State Vendors Revolving Fund (Fund 270), the sum of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Office of Management and Enterprise Services by law.

SECTION 4. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Office of Management and Enterprise Services is hereby authorized to

    expend during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, from the Vendor
