**Research Analysis**

HB 1007 requires that professional development programs for teachers and administrators include consent and healthy relationships education. The measure also allows the Safe School Committee to include in its recommendations to district boards of education the development of a consent and healthy relationships education program. Finally, the State Department of Education is directed to develop training materials for school districts regarding the components that should be included in a rape or sexual assault response program and a consent and healthy relationships program.

**Fiscal Analysis**

OSDE believes that a system enhancement is required to build the application that will allow tracking the implementation and evaluation of the program by school districts. Based on the estimate received from OMES ISD, the technical work is expected to cost approximately \$14,400. This will include the capacity to collect the data and a check box to certify completion of training by district staff and audit by the Regional Accreditation Officers.

Districts may also incur a cost but it is hard to determine the impact without any knowledge of the level of effort required.
