Research Analysis

The Senate amendments to HB1018 delete the requirement that HIV instruction include information about refusal skills, negotiating skills, and peer-resistance skills.

The measure requires that each school district provide age-appropriate instruction of HIV, AIDS, and related issues at least once during grades 5-6, at least once during grades 7-9, and at least once during grades 10-12.

The bill directs the State Department of Education to make available medically accurate curriculum, however, school districts possess the option to create their own curriculum provided it is approved for medical accuracy by the State Department of Health.

The provisions of the measure are required to comply with the Parents' Bill of Rights.
