## **Research Analysis**

HB 1020 provides that beginning January 1, 2021, no person is to be convicted of failure to appear if the court has not instituted a notification system that gives notification of court dates for an individual by telephone no later than 72 hours after the court date is set and that allows the individual to access information about his or her court date by telephone. The notification system shall include the date, time and location of the expected court appearance. The court is to also create a publicly available website that publishes all expected court appearances no later than 72 hours after the court date is set.
