Research Analysis

HB1055, as proposed committee substitute, directs the State Department of Health to create a permit for unattended food establishments. Permit fees may not exceed \$150 per year. Unattended food establishments must obtain a permit in order to operate. Unattended food establishments must:

- Be located in the interior of a building
- Only provide food that is packaged and labeled as defined by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) Food Code
- Only provide food and beverages for individual sale (not in bulk)

The measure further provides restrictions on establishments' refrigeration units. The measure places cleaning requirements for surface areas. The measure requires establishments utilize continuous video surveillance. The measure requires that permit-holders periodically assess their establishments' compliance with their permits. The measure requires that a sign be placed in front of establishments to inform customers of the responsible business entities. The measure requires establishments to obtain an Oklahoma sales tax permit before conducting any sales. Lastly, the measure directs the State Commissioner of Health to promulgate rules.
