Potential Reduced Registration Revenue To Non-Appropriated Agencies

Fiscal Analysis

The amendment changes references of the commission of a misdemeanor and inserts in lieu the application of an administrative fine. While the amount of the administrative fine could reach a maximum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00), the amount of any potential fine revenue will be dependent on the number of such fines and the amounts of fines applied.

Also, the manufactured home salesperson registration is reduced from fifty dollars (\$50.00) to twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). This may result in an unknown decrease in registration revenue to the Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission resulting from the reduced registration cost. Information included in the database of the Used Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission related to manufactured home sales persons indicated approximately 225 persons were listed as licensees. Current license and renewal indicates a fifty dollar (\$50.00) current costs. The actual potential revenue decrease will depend on the number of registrations.
