**Research Analysis**

The CS for HB 1108 changes the composition of the State Fire Marshal Commission from seven members appointed by the governor to eight members appointed by the Governor, Speaker, and President Pro Tempore; the members serve at the pleasure of their appointing authority. The ninth member of the commission is the State Fire Marshal, who is appointed by the Governor.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 1108, as introduced, deals with making the State Fire Marshal Commission into an advisory body and transferring all duties of the Commission to the State Fire Marshal. It also increases the membership from 7 to 9 members. According to the State Fire Marshal, there is no anticipated fiscal or revenue impact on the non-appropriated state agency.
