Research Analysis

HB 1158 allows cases relating to physical or deadly force against an intruder to be appealed to the Court of Criminal Appeals upon a pretrial order, decision or judgment granting immunity from criminal prosecution or civil action. The measure allows the State to appeal an adverse ruling or order of a magistrate which grants immunity from criminal prosecution or civil action pursuant to the use of physical or deadly force against an intruder.
