Research Analysis

The Floor Amendment to HB 1229 eliminates the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board and transfers its various duties and responsibilities to the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability.

The Amendment renames the “Statewide Virtual Charter School Revolving Fund” as the “Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability Revolving Fund” and transfers the fund from the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board to the Commission for Educational Quality and Accountability.

The amendment also changes the composition of the Commission.

The amendment allows the Commission to renegotiate contracts with each statewide virtual charter school which has been approved and sponsored by the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board or any virtual charter school for which the Statewide Virtual Charter School Board has assumed sponsorship.

The amendment also allows the Governor to appoint the Administrator of the Office of the Educational Quality and Accountability.
