Fiscal Analysis

HB 1271 in its current form exempts 60% disabled veterans from the requirement to pay tolls on the Oklahoma Turnpike System. Officials from the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) estimate approximately 56,600 Oklahomans would qualify as 60% disabled veterans. The Oklahoma Turnpike Authority (OTA) estimate loss of annual toll revenue of approximately \$53 per person, for a total annual cost of \$3,000,000 to OTA. OTA is a nonappropriated state agency, therefor, the agency would have to absorb the cost within the agency's budget structure. The measure is expected to have no impact on state appropriations.
