Research Analysis

HB1280, as introduced, relates to Mental Health and Substance Abuse Services Law. The measure modifies the definition of “assisted outpatient” to include community-based structured crisis centers as hospitalization location for individual struggling to comply with mental illness treatment. The measure allows licensed mental health professionals to offer alcohol and drug substance abuse course (ADSAC) assessments.
